



## CSP Radio Protocol Card (TS04)

### Requesting Authority to Pass through Work Area

#### Operator (initiates call)

- **(Phonetic call sign)** This is (train number), en route for (location) (\* on the up/down line). I am stopped at your "Compulsory Stop Board", between (station) and (station)
- **Over.**

#### Infrastructure (Acknowledgement)

- (Train number), This is **(Phonetic call sign)**,
- You are authorised to pass my "Compulsory Stop Board" [**\*\* after the signal has been set to proceed**] (\* on the up/down line) and proceed through the work area.  
{- advise Operator of any speed restriction(s) required}
- **Over.**

#### Operator

- **Roger – (Phonetic call sign)** Pass your "Compulsory Stop Board" (\* on the up/down line) and proceed through the work area {- repeat speed restriction(s) advised}
- **Over.**

#### Infrastructure (Acknowledgement)

- **Roger –** (Train number), that is correct, **(Phonetic call sign)**
- **Out.**  
\* use up/down line where appropriate  
**\*\* When the RPO has arranged for a signal to be held at STOP, the RPO must contact the Signaller to authorise clearance of the signal for the train**
